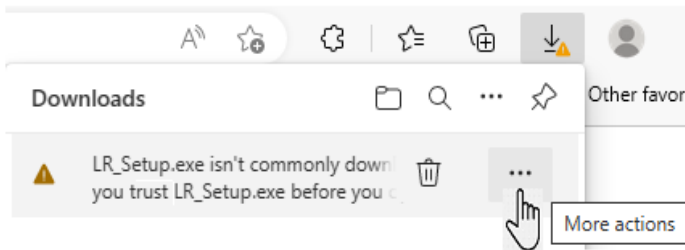
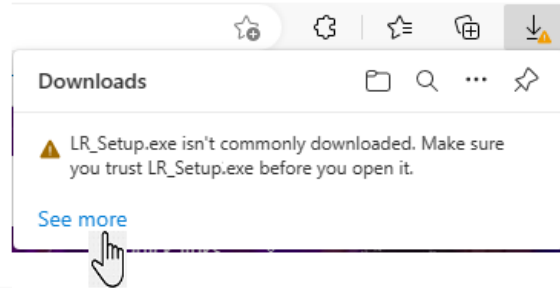


## LANDLORD'S RECORDKEEPER DOWNLOAD NOTES (Windows 11)

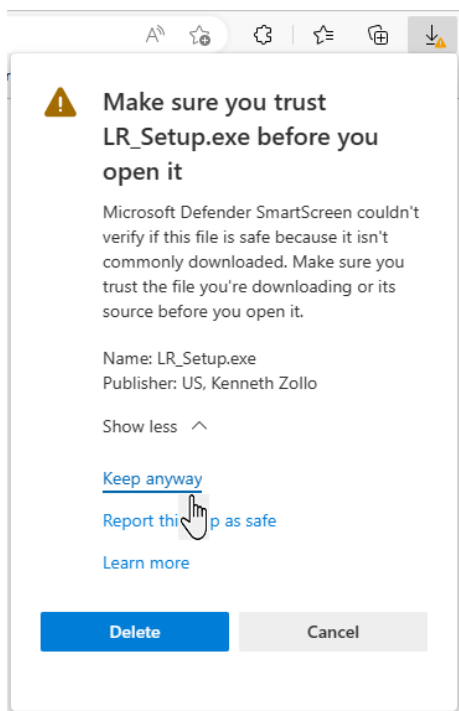
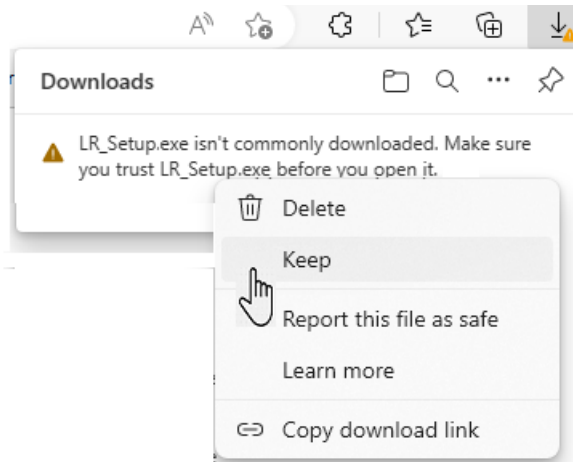
Microsoft changed the way downloads are handled in Windows 11. When attempting to download a software file that is not “recognized”, *Windows Defender* (the built-in malware protection) will intercept the download. **Shining Key Software** is a small independent developer and has not yet logged the hundreds of thousands of downloads needed for its classification by the major companies as a “trusted” source, so our download will almost certainly be targeted as a possible threat.

During the download, you will probably see a small dialog like the one on the picture (from the Edge browser on Windows 11). To allow the download to continue, choose **See more**.



You might also see the **more actions** icon. Click it for a list of choices.

Select **Keep** from the list to instruct Windows to allow the download to be completed without further interruption.



Once the file **LR\_Setup** has been successfully downloaded, *Windows Defender* notifies you again that the file is not recognized (it's not yet earned its way into Microsoft's list of “safe” programs). Use the **Keep anyway** option to tell your system that the file should be marked as OK to open and run.
